The [chronic subdural hematoma](#) was originally termed “[pachymeningitis hemorrhagica interna](#)” by [Rudolf Ludwig Karl Virchow](#) in [1857](#) ¹⁾.

Pituitary [metastases](#) (PM) is a rare complication of advanced malignancy, first reported by L. Benjamin in [1857](#) as a case of [melanoma](#) spread to the [pituitary](#) identified in an [autopsy](#) ²⁾ and later in [1913](#), [Harvey Williams Cushing](#) ³⁾
