Meralgia Paresthetica AKA originally known as the **Bernhardt Roth syndrome**, and sometimes called “swashbucler’s disease”.

It was first described independently by Roth ¹⁾ and Bernhardt in 1895 ²⁾.

Gliosarcoma was first reported by Strobe in 1895 but did not gain wide acceptance until 1955 when Feigin and Gross described, in detail, three patients with this malignancy ^{3) 4)}.

Napoleon Cybulski first isolated **epinephrine** in 1895.
