## 1894-1896

**Meralgia Paresthetica** AKA originally known as the **Bernhardt Roth syndrome**, and sometimes called “swashbuckler’s disease”.

It was first described independently by Roth <sup>1)</sup>. and Bernhardt in 1895 <sup>2)</sup>.

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**Gliosarcoma** was first reported by Strobe in 1895 but did not gain wide acceptance until 1955 when Feigin and Gross described, in detail, three patients with this malignancy <sup>3) 4)</sup>.

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Napoleon Cybulski first isolated **epinephrine** in 1895.
