Harvey Cushing ¹⁾, in 1905, attempted to remove an intramedullary spinal cord tumor but aborted the procedure after a dorsal column myelotomy.

Harvey Cushing's paper, "The special field of neurological surgery," published in the Bulletin of The Johns Hopkins Hospital in 1905, constitutes a recognized milestone in the establishment of neurological surgery as a separate surgical specialty in the United States ²⁾.

The unilateral suboccipital approach was popularized by Woolsey (1903) and with great contributions by Fedor Krause (1905).

After several refinements and modifications through different dedicated neurosurgeons (Fish, House and Seiffert , Dandy's suboccipital approach (1917) with an ipsilateral suboccipital flap evolved to the retrosigmoid transmeatal approach.
