The [pineal region](#) is a exceptional [intracranial epidermoid cyst](#). [Harvey Williams Cushing](#) was the first to report the [pineal](#) localization of the epidermoid cyst in [1928](#).

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In [1928](#), Cushing and Bailey classified [cavernous malformations](#) as a solid subtype of [hemangioblastomas](#) <sup>1)</sup>.

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They distinguished meningothelial, fibroblastic, and angiomatic subtypes, and to this day allocation to subtype is based solely on histological findings.
