The first use of [fluorescence](#) for brain tumor surgery was in [1948](#) by G.E. Moore ¹⁾ using [fluorescein sodium](#).

Bilateral [cingulotomy](#) is a form of [psychosurgery](#), introduced in [1948](#) as an alternative to [lobotomy](#).

The Ferguson method for the study of [scoliosis](#) was first described in [1930](#) ²⁾, and the Cobb method, which is still considered the state of the art, was introduced in [1948](#) ³⁾.

[Parsonage-Turner Syndrome](#) is named after Maurice Parsonage and John Turner and published in *The Lancet* in [1948](#) by Parsonage and Turner ⁴⁾. The condition, subsequently coined Parsonage-Turner Syndrome, had been previously described in the literature as far back as [1897](#) with many similar clinical presentations of the syndrome reported prior to the extensive study of the syndrome by Parsonage and Turner.

Neurosurgical service in [Indonesia](#) was first established in [1948](#) at Princess Margriet Hospital in [Jakarta](#) (previously known as Batavia) by the Dutch Red Cross during the war for Indonesian independence.
