The [German Neurosurgery Society](#) was founded in [1950](#) with 1,300 members.

[Diffuse idiopathic skeletal hyperostosis](#) (DISH), also referred to as [Forestier's disease](#), was first described by Jacques Forestier and his student Jaume Rotes-Querol in [1950](#).¹⁾.

In [1950](#), working in [Johannesburg, South Africa](#), Krynauw reported on 12 patients with [infantile hemiplegia](#) who underwent [hemispherectomy](#); seizure control was achieved in 10 of these patients, with improvement in function and behavior²⁾.

Intra-arterial (IA) delivery of chemotherapeutic agents for brain tumors was introduced as a therapeutic option as far back as [1950](#) by Klopp et al in animals³⁾ and [1952](#) by French et al in humans⁴⁾.


