

# 360° fusion

Combined anterior/posterior [procedure](#).

For patients with [ankylosing spondylitis](#) and [subaxial cervical spine fractures](#) or dislocations, when surgical stabilization is required, posterior long-segment [instrumentation](#) and [fusion](#) or a combined anterior/posterior [procedure \(360° fusion\)](#). Anterior [stand-alone instrumentation](#) and [fusion](#) [\[\[procedure\]\]s](#) are associated with a failure rate of up to 50% in these patients <sup>1)</sup>.
