

360° fusion

Combined anterior/posterior [procedure](#).

For patients with [ankylosing spondylitis](#) and [subaxial cervical spine fractures](#) or dislocations, when surgical stabilization is required, posterior long-segment [instrumentation](#) and [fusion](#) or a combined anterior/posterior [procedure](#) ([360° fusion](#)). Anterior [stand-alone instrumentation](#) and fusion [\[\[procedure\]\]](#)s are associated with a failure rate of up to 50% in these patients ¹⁾.
