

A 57 year-old man with lateral **abdominal wall bulging**. MRI showed thoracic **disk herniation** at the T11-T12 level. Needle **electromyogram** disclosed acute **demyelination** in paraspinal and **abdominal muscles** innervated from **thoracic spinal nerve 11**. Eight months later the swelling was reduced significantly. Thoracic disc herniations are rare and three similar cases have been described previously ¹⁾.
