

1. Academic Degree (Education) An academic qualification awarded by a university or college upon completion of a study program.

Types of Degrees: Associate Degree – A two-year undergraduate program. Bachelor's Degree (e.g., B.A., B.Sc.) – A four-year undergraduate program. Master's Degree (e.g., M.A., M.Sc.) – A postgraduate qualification requiring specialized study. Doctoral Degree (Ph.D.) – The highest academic degree, involving original research.
