

# Acetylcholine

Botulinum toxin A (BTX-A) inhibits acetylcholine exocytosis from parasympathetic postganglionic nerves to the M2 and M3 receptors of the detrusor, inhibiting detrusor contraction. BTX-A (100– 200u) is injected into the detrusor muscle during cystoscopy. It decreases overactivity, urgency, and storage pressures <sup>1)</sup>
