Unfortunately, [journals](#), [indexers](#), [academic institutions](#), and funding bodies are not considering these [contributions](#) as curricular [merits](#). Pharmacy Practice started a new [practice](#) of including all peer reviewers of the past year as part of the collective [author](#) in the first [editorial](#) of the new year. Thus, their names are searchable in [PubMed](#) using the [IR] field descriptor <sup>1)</sup> <sup>2)</sup>.


