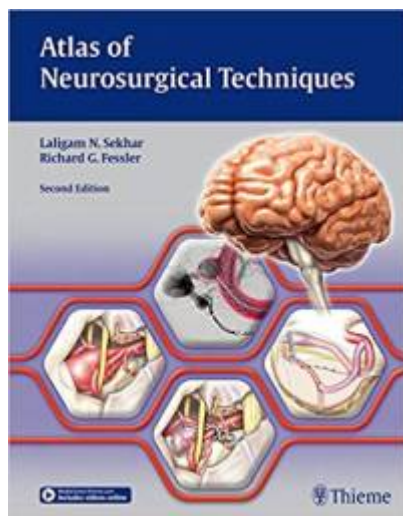


Atlas of Neurosurgical Techniques: Brain
