

For the [operating room](#) management, the basis is the surgical [suite](#), and evaluation can be divided into the duration of [anesthesia](#), [operation time](#), [operating room time](#), and [operating room preparation time](#). Anesthesia duration is divided into four moments: [anesthetic induction](#), [maintenance](#), [awakening](#), and [recovery](#). The operative time consists of [dieresis](#), [hemostasis](#), [exeresis](#), and [suture](#). [Operating room](#) time includes patient stay, from arrival to exit. Operating room preparation time ([turnover](#)) is the time between one patient leaving and another entering, including cleaning and replacing the necessary material. The lengthiest stage during a procedure is anesthesia.
