

AKA arthrosis interspinosa. Radiographically: contact of adjacent [spinous processes](#) (“kissing spines”) with enlargement, flattening and reactive sclerosis of apposing interspinous surfaces. Most common at L4-5. Produces localized midline lumbar pain & tenderness on back extension relieved by flexion, local anesthetic injection or partial excision of the involved spinous processes
