

Barrow Neurological Institute Pain Scale

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- 1 No [pain](#), no [medications](#)
- 2 Occasional pain, no medications required
- 3A- No pain, continued medication
- 3B- persistent pain, controlled with medications
- 4 Some pain, not adequately controlled with medications
- 5 Severe pain or no pain relief

The [Visual Analog Scale](#) (VAS) and the [Barrow Neurological Institute Pain Scale](#) (BNI-PS) are 2 of the most frequently employed patient-reported outcome (PRO) tools used by clinicians to rate [pain intensity](#) for patients with [trigeminal neuralgia](#) (TN).

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
