

Baseline data

The objective data obtained from a patient or subject set before [randomization](#) and entry in a clinical trial.

The initial collection of [data](#) serves as a basis for comparison with the subsequently acquired data.

Baseline data is a measurement of the behavior taken before interventions are started. Baseline data is important because it allows the team to compare the behavior before and after the implementation of the behavior plan to determine if the interventions are working.

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
