

Benign intracranial hypertension

Idiopathic intracranial hypertension is the preferred term for this condition, replacing **pseudotumor cerebri**, which often includes cerebral **venous sinus thrombosis** and other etiologies of **Intracranial hypertension**, and **benign intracranial hypertension**, which does not take into account that some IIH patients do not have a “benign” course and go on to irreversibly **vision loss** ¹⁾.
