A bilateral subdural hematoma involves bleeding on both sides of the brain between the dura mater (the tough outer membrane covering the brain) and the brain itself. This type of hematoma is characterized by:

Bilateral: Affecting both sides of the brain. Subdural: Occurring beneath the dura mater, the outermost layer of the meninges. Hematoma: A localized collection of blood outside of blood vessels.
