

Brain Abscess after chalazion

A 15-year-old boy with frontal and [ethmoidal sinusitis](#) with inflammatory orbital infiltration and subacute eyelid swelling. The cerebral imaging showed an encapsulated [brain abscess](#) so that an urgent surgical removal of the abscess cavity was indicated. After several [neurosurgical procedures](#) a complete remission of the [abscess](#) could be achieved. In spite of the large abscess in the frontal lobe the boy never showed any [neurological symptoms](#) or psychiatric symptoms.

In atypical courses of a [chalazion](#) the clinical picture requires further diagnosis including evaluation and imaging in otorhinolaryngology and neurology ¹⁾.
