

### c-Myc (Myc proto-oncogene):

c-Myc is an oncogene and transcription factor that regulates cell growth and proliferation. In the context of reprogramming, c-Myc enhances the efficiency of iPSC generation but is not strictly required. However, its overexpression raises concerns about potential tumorigenicity in iPSC-derived cells.
