The ophthalmic segment of the [internal carotid artery](#), running from the [distal dural ring](#) to the [posterior communicating artery](#) (PCOM), can give rise to aneurysms <sup>1)</sup>.

A 1- or 2-mm segment of naked internal carotid artery lies between the investment of the [carotid cistern](#) and the dura of the [cavernous sinus](#).
