

Calcium binding proteins have specific domains that bind to [calcium](#) and are known to be heterogenous. One of the functions of Calcium binding proteins is to regulate the amount of free (unbound) Ca^{2+} in the [cytosol](#) of the cell. Regulation of Ca^{2+} is known as Calcium homeostasis.
