Calcium binding proteins have specific domains that bind to calcium and are known to be heterogenous. One of the functions of Calcium binding proteins is to regulate the amount of free (unbound) Ca2+ in the cytosol of the cell. Regulation of Ca(2+) is known as Calcium homeostasis.
