

A carotid body tumor, also known as a [chemodectoma](#) or [paraganglioma](#), is a tumor located on the side of the neck, where the large carotid artery branches into smaller blood vessels to carry blood into the brain. The cluster of cells around that branching is called the carotid body, or carotid glomus.
