

Cerebrospinal fluid overdrainage

drip chamber falls to floor:

- a) overdrainage, possible [seizures](#) and/or [subdural hematoma](#) formation
- b) solution: securely tape chamber to pole, bed-rail..., check position regularly.ç

Lobar hemorrhage at site remote from [craniotomy](#). In a series of 37 patients, unlike hematomas at the craniotomy site, the following were identified as not being related to risk of hemorrhage: HTN, coagulopathy, CSF drainage, underlying occult lesion following drainage of chronic SDH , and cerebellar hemorrhage following pterional craniotomy ¹⁾ (this author incriminated possibly rapid overdrainage of CSF), or following [temporal lobectomy](#) ²⁾.
