

The epithelial cells of the choroid plexus secrete cerebrospinal fluid (CSF), by a process that involves the movement of Na(+), Cl(-) and HCO₃(-) from the blood to the ventricles of the brain. This creates the osmotic gradient, which drives the secretion of H₂O.
