


Cervical sagittal computed tomography

Usually the optimal manner to identify [locked facets](#).

The [K-line](#) is a straight line connecting the midpoints of the [cervical spinal canal](#) at C2 and C7 on a neutral [cervical lateral radiograph](#).



The maximum occupying ratio of the [cervical ossification of the posterior longitudinal ligament \(OPLL\)](#) is calculated from a [cervical sagittal computed tomography](#).
