

Cervical spine instability

Cervical spine instability is frequently discovered accidentally in an [asymptomatic](#) patient, especially in [connective tissue](#) disorders associated with [ligamentous laxity](#), and in congenital anomalies. The second clinical picture is that of [torticollis](#) associated with variable trauma. Rarely is a neurological deficit the revealing clinical sign.
