


Cingulate sulcus sign

The [cingulate sulcus](#) sign has been proposed as being useful as an [MRI](#) feature of [idiopathic normal pressure hydrocephalus](#) (NPH). It denotes the posterior part of the [cingulate](#) sulcus being narrower than the anterior part. The divider between the anterior and posterior parts of the [sulcus](#) being a line drawn parallel to the floor of the [fourth ventricle](#) ¹⁾.
