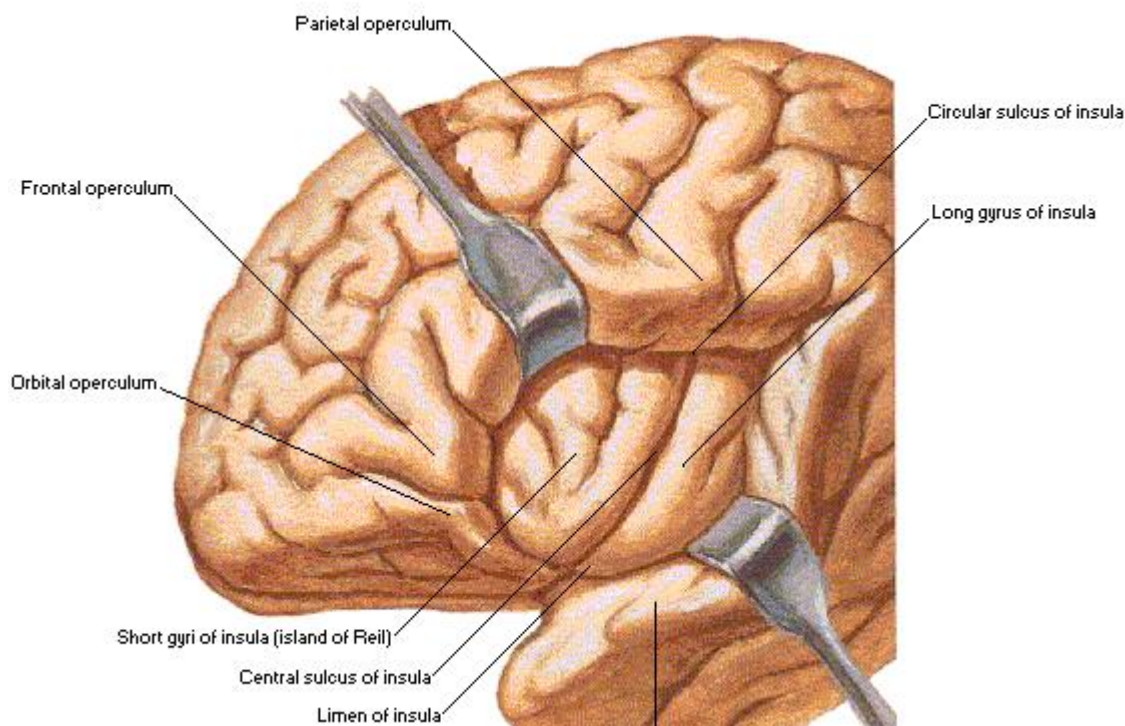




Circular Sulcus (circS) is the sulcus that runs all around the [insula](#), separating it from the temporal, frontal and parietal lobes. This sulcus cannot be easily followed on the surface rendering because it is always partially covered.

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
