

Coincident cervical and lumbar spinal stenosis

In 5%, lumbar and cervical stenoses are symptomatic simultaneously.

Coincident symptomatic lumbar and cervical spinal stenosis is usually managed by first decompressing the [cervical region](#), and later operating on the [lumbar region](#) (unless severe [neurogenic claudication](#) dominates the picture). It is also possible, in selected cases, to operate on both in a single sitting.
