

The Far-lateral approach is a versatile approach and is useful for a variety of lesions located ventrolateral to the brainstem and upper cervical cord. It allows adequate exposure with minimal retraction. Most of the [foramen magnum meningiomas](#) can be excised either without or with only partial resection of the [condyle](#)¹⁾.

Seoane et al²⁾ reported a surgical series using the far-lateral approach to PICA aneurysms without [condylar resection](#).
