

Cortical remapping, also referred to as cortical reorganization, is when a cortical map is affected by a stimulus, is changed and then creates a 'new' cortical map.

Neuroscientific evidence has revealed that the adult brain is capable of substantial [plastic change](#) in such areas as the primary somatosensory cortex that were formerly thought to be modifiable only during early experience.
