

In 1958 Gillingham popularized wrapping with cotton or muslin <sup>1)</sup>. An analysis of 60 patients showed that 8.5% rebled in  $\leq 6$  mos, and the annual rebleeding rate was 1.5% thereafter <sup>2)</sup> (similar to the natural history)
