Traditionally, [galeal flap](#) or cranialization was often used to reconstruct the [skull base defect](#) caused by [trauma](#) or [tumor](#) removal. However, in the case of a huge skull base defect, galeal flap is not enough to block the communication between [nasal cavity](#) and [intracranial](#) space.
