

Craniopharyngioma surgery complications

The proximity of [craniopharyngiomas](#) (CPs) to critical neurovascular structures can lead to a host of neurologic and endocrine complications that lead to difficulty with surgical management.

SIADH

[Central diabetes insipidus](#): Usually only occurs postoperatively since damage to [pituitary](#) or lower [pituitary stalk](#) does not prevent production and release of [ADH](#) by [hypothalamic nuclei](#).
