

Cryptococcoma

Cryptococcoma (mucinous pseudocyst): a parenchymal collection that occurs almost exclusively in [AIDS](#) patients. Much less common than cryptococcal meningitis. No enhancement of the lesion or the meninges. Usually, 3-10 mm in diameter and are frequently located in the basal ganglia (due to spread by small perforating vessels)
