The adjective data-driven means that progress in an activity is compelled by data, rather than by intuition or by personal experience. The term is often labeled[by whom?] as business jargon for what scientists call evidence-based decision making. This often refers to:

Data-driven programming Data-driven journalism Data-driven testing Data-driven learning Data-driven science Data-driven marketing, a form of digital marketing Data-driven management
