

Diffuse astrocytic tumor

In the [World Health Organization Classification of Tumors of the Central Nervous System 2016](#)¹⁾ the term diffuse astrocytic tumors (sometimes called [diffuse astrocytomas](#)) refers to the class of infiltrating CNS tumors composed of astrocytes (sometimes called [diffuse gliomas](#)), whereas the term diffuse astrocytoma can refer to a lower grade ([WHO grade II](#)) subset of this class, with higher grade lesions consisting of [anaplastic astrocytoma](#) ([WHO grade III](#)) and [glioblastoma](#) ([WHO grade IV](#)).
