Dissection [maneuvers](#) can be divided into two types: [sharp dissection](#) with [microscissors](#) and [blunt dissection](#) using a [dissector](#).

Dissection is a blister-like de-lamination between the outer and inner walls of a blood vessel, generally originating with a partial leak in the inner lining.

Sylvian dissection.

Pure [fusiform aneurysms](#) without [dissection](#) are considered to have a low risk of rupture. Furthermore, aneurysm wall with atherosclerotic change tends to be less susceptible to rupture.
