A multivesicular [hydatid cyst](#) is a manifestation of [echinococcosis](#), a parasitic disease caused by the tapeworm [Echinococcus](#).

Molecular re-evaluation of [Echinococcus granulosus](#), which causes cystic echinococcosis (CE), has revealed that it is not a single species, but instead consists of 5 cryptic species. Among them, *E. granulosus* (dog-sheep strain) is predominant (75%) followed by *Echinococcus canadensis* (22%). The major affected organs, in humans, are the liver (88%) and lungs (11%) ¹⁾.
