### ☐ General Scope

Epilepsia Open is the open-access journal of the ILAE, established to promote high-quality epilepsy research, including:

- · Basic and translational neuroscience
- Clinical studies
- Negative and confirmatory trials
- · Case series and historical perspectives
- · Systematic reviews and policy commentaries

It offers rapid publication and accepts a broad range of manuscript types, supporting methodological transparency and underreported results.

### Strengths

- Rapid review and publication
  - Median time to first decision: ~41 days
  - Online publication post-acceptance: <3 weeks</li>
- Support for underrepresented research
  - Accepts negative, confirmatory, and hypothesis-generating studies
- Strong international visibility
  - Well indexed and backed by ILAE
- Thematic flexibility
  - Welcomes special issues and diverse formats (e.g., methodological notes, community perspectives)

### **∧** Limitations

- Moderate APC (~2,500 USD)
  - May limit submissions from low-income countries
- Acceptance rate ~58%
  - Suggests moderate editorial selectivity compared to top-tier epilepsy journals
- Lower IF than flagship journal
  - Epilepsia has an IF ~6.6, indicating higher prestige and citation influence
- Review transparency limited
  - Details on peer-review depth and reproducibility standards not consistently disclosed

Growing submission volume may challenge editorial coherence
