

Fibrosarcoma

A [sarcoma](#) in which the predominant cell type is a malignant [fibroblast](#).

In the [skull](#), it appears as a [radiolucency](#) or bone defect.

The malignant transformation from a [chordoma](#) into fibrosarcoma or [malignant fibrous histiocytoma](#) is rare.

The malignant transformation of a [fibrous dysplasia](#) occurs in < 1% of cases ¹⁾ typically to [osteosarcoma](#), but other [sarcomas](#) are possible (fibrosarcoma, [chondrosarcoma](#)...)
