

A Folliculostellate (FS) cell is a type of non-endocrine cell found in the anterior lobe of the pituitary gland.

Pituicytoma is a rare [glial sellar/suprasellar neoplasm](#) arising in the [neurohypophysis](#) with a possible origin from the [folliculostellate cells](#) of the [adenohypophysis](#) <sup>1)</sup> <sup>2)</sup>.
