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The division of the [cerebrum](#) into 5 lobes is widely accepted in the scientific community. Despite this, a history of the lobes of the [brain](#) has not been discussed in the [literature](#). Therefore, a article recounts this history with emphasis on the contributions of [Thomas Willis](#) (1664), [Felix Vicq d'Azyr](#) (1796), [Johann Christian Reil](#) (1796), [François Chaussier](#) (1807), and [Louis Pierre Gratiolet](#) and [François Leuret](#) (1857) into one of the most widely accepted concepts in neuroanatomy ¹⁾
