

Frontal bossing

The protuberance of the [frontal bone](#). Forehead appears prominent. May be associated with an exaggerated brow ridge.

Etiologies include:

1. hydrocephalus in a young child
2. acromegaly
3. fibrous dysplasia
4. extramedullary hematopoiesis
5. [achondroplasia](#)
6. Hurler syndrome

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
