

Frontal sinus cranialization technique

For this [procedure](#), the [bicoronal approach](#) is normally used. However, if present, lacerations can be used to directly access fracture sites for fracture management.

While elevating the coronal [flap](#), is critical to maintaining the integrity of the [pericranial flap](#). It may be necessary for the repair of dural [lacerations](#).
