A functional state refers to the physiological condition or activity status of a cell, tissue, or organism, reflecting its role and behavior in a given environment. In cellular biology, the functional state often highlights how a cell's characteristics (e.g., phenotype, metabolism, and secretory profile) adapt in response to external stimuli or internal cues.
